New Park News:

Store Hours- Monday, Tuesday, Friday, Saturday & Sunday 10am- 6pm. Wednesday & Thursday 2pm- 7pm. If no one is in the store at during those times, please see the sign on the door indicating where you can find a caretaker in the park.

The pool is still being repaired. The leak detection company came out and assessed the situation and needs to come back mid- May to have another look at the pool. As soon as we receive the pool report back from the company, we will inform the members. Also, if anyone has any ideas on a reopening plan for the pool and how we stay within the COVID-19 guidelines and restrictions, please email the park at wwpark@outlook.com.

Potholes around the park are being repaired. Bushes blocking intersections have been trimmed back.

****Reminder****- Dumpsters are for everything BUT grass and limbs. Please haul the grass and limbs to the appropriate place at the dump site. Dumpsters are in the park now and available to be used!

An arrow pointing to your lot needs to be placed by MAY 15th. May 15th is the deadline for lot clean up. Please have your lots cleaned before then to not receive a fine. If you have any questions about the lot clean up, please feel free to contact Lisa Niels or Mark Burlingame.

The women's showers are being repaired. We are waiting on the piece to fix it to come in. Like everything else, COVID has delayed the parts getting to us from the manufacturer.

Propane cost is 3.00/ gallon. Ice is 3.00 a bag. Flags are 15.00/each. ATV/UTV stickers are 25.00/ each. Any vehicle that cruises around the park must have a 2021 sticker on it. Be sure to check out the new store location!

Water at the park is turned on and all the field bathrooms have been opened. Some bathroom stalls are missing locks on the doors, but they will be replaced once they locks are in from back order.

If you are needing a new card for park entry/ exit, please contact Deanna Courts. Also please let Deanna know if you have lost any cards or any of them are broken so they can be turned off.

Any complaints need to be filled out on a park complaint form. They are located at the store or on the website and Facebook page. Please fill them out and return them back to the store or email them to wwpark@outlook.com. They will be addressed by the complaint committee and handled appropriately. Board members will not be taking complaints at their lots anymore. We need the proper documentation for all complaints. Any matters that need addressing right away must be to be reported to the caretakers.

PLEASE make sure that all guests on your lot know and follow the rules. **This goes for ATV/ golf cart use for speed limits and riding time. Please make sure that all riders under 16 are off ALL motorized vehicles at 7pm, year-round.** Please do your part to make sure these rules are adhered to.
